FAC Theatre Presents *Jagged Little Pill: The Musical* *“You Oughta Know” this Tony Award-Winning Hit Arrives on the FAC Mainstage April 30-May 24, 2026*

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo.—April 16, 2026—The Colorado Springs Fine Arts Center at Colorado College (FAC) will present *Alanis Morissette's Jagged Little Pill: The Musical* on the Mainstage from April 30 through May 24, 2026. Featuring lyrics by Alanis Morissette, music by Alanis Morissette and Glen Ballard, and a book by Academy Award-winning writer Diablo Cody, the acclaimed production brings Morissette's iconic music to life in a powerful theatrical experience.

Centered on the seemingly picture-perfect Healy family, *Jagged Little Pill* explores what happens when long-buried truths begin to surface. As the family confronts personal struggles and societal pressures, they must decide whether to preserve appearances or face difficult realities about themselves, their relationships, and the world around them.

Inspired by Alanis Morissette's groundbreaking music, this Tony and Grammy Award-winning musical offers a moving portrait of a modern American family navigating identity, healing, and connection. The production features beloved songs from Morissette's landmark album *Jagged Little Pill* and beyond, woven into a story filled with resilience, love, and hope.

“Jagged Little Pill is a bold and emotionally resonant work that speaks directly to the complexities of contemporary life,” said FAC Theatre Company Producing Artistic Director Chris Sheley. “We are excited to bring this dynamic and deeply human story to our Mainstage and invite audiences to experience Alanis Morissette's music combined with her message that have made this production so impactful.”

Notable creatives in the production include the director and the choreographer with eight Broadway credits between them. [Michael Bello \(director\)](#) was recently the associate director on the Broadway smash revival of *The Who's Tommy*. And [Sarah Parker \(choreographer\)](#) was the associate choreographer on the Broadway smash revival

of *The Who's Tommy*. Additionally, she just concluded a three-year appearance in the Alicia Keys' Broadway smash hit of *Hell's Kitchen*.

Also notable are performances by local fan favorites, Broadway veterans and owners of ICONS bar in downtown Colorado Springs, [John Wolfe](#) and [Josh Franklin](#). They were last seen on the FAC Mainstage starring as Bert and Mr. Banks in the FAC Theatre Company's smash hit *Mary Poppins*.
