### Mentorship Program Highlights

Our recent survey shows that the Spring 2025 Mentorship Program was a huge success, creating meaningful connections and fostering personal and professional growth for everyone involved.

### High Satisfaction and Strong Connections

The program received exceptionally high marks, especially from our mentees. A remarkable 75% of mentees reported being "Extremely satisfied" with their experience, and 100% of mentees rated their connection with their mentor as either "Strong" or "Very strong". This highlights the significant impact the program has on our mentees' journeys.
