Best Practices of Community-Engaged Learning Course Design

DEVE	LOP

Actively develop engaged citizenship knowledge, skills, and motivation to develop students into *lifelong* changemakers, beyond the class.

CO-EDUCATE

Bring community voices and expertise into the classroom as co-educators, centering expertise often excluded academic settings

PREPARE

Prepare students to be intentional, informed, and follow best practices of community work

ASSESS

Assess student learning gained through the community experience/project.

REFLECT

Provide structured, explicit opportunities to connect theory to practice.

INTEGRATE: ENRICH and APPLY

Integrate with classroom learning goals. Community experience enriches student learning of course content, and students have the opportunity to apply course content to real issues, contexts, and problems.

INCORPORATE

Incorporate community experiences, projects, and/or assignments into the classroom

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
