Garden of the Gods

1805 N. 30th St.

Our very own National Landmark! Walk, run, roll, or climb (with a permit) through one of Colorado Springs' most famous public parks. Don't miss the gravity-defying Balanced Rock or the prehistoric waves of water imprinted on the stone.

Red Rock Canyon Open Space

3550 W. High St.

A popular dog-walking, running, and mountain biking destination with beautiful views of Pikes Peak and Garden of the Gods. Fun fact: the Lyons sandstone that was used to build CC's Palmer Hall was quarried here!

Downtown Manitou Springs

Manitou Ave., Manitou Springs
An artsy, hippie town populated with groovy art galleries and eclectic shops. Go on a scavenger hunt to find all eight natural spring water fountains scattered throughout the town, featuring effervescent water rumored to have healing properties.

Manitou Incline

475 Ruxton Ave., Manitou Springs Grab a reservation for 2000 feet of elevation gain in just a 0.9 mile hike. It's an intense trek up the old cog railway. Olympians do it. CC Students do it. Can you?

Drive or take the cog railway up "America's Mountain" to see what inspired Katharine Lee Bates's classic, "America the Beautiful." Standing at 14,115 feet, you can cross off your first of over 50 "fourteeners" in the state.
