



HOW TO APPLY FOR A BLOCK ABROAD OR AWAY

LEARN ABOUT UPCOMING BLOCKS AWAY

Visit the Study Away Fair in Block 5 to learn about next year's offerings, and speak to the faculty leaders about their programs. Find complete program information on the Global Education website!

APPLY TO THE BLOCK AWAY ON SUMMIT DURING THE APPLICATION PERIOD

- Block 5 (Late Jan. to mid-March is the primary application window for all of next year's blocks away.
- While it is possible to apply after the window, aid and space in the program will be much harder to obtain.



LATE APPLICATION IS RISKY: Aid is limited and may be gone if you apply after the Block 5 primary application period ends.

CONFIRM YOUR SPOT

- Return to Summit and complete required forms to confirm your spot.
- Students who do not confirm before their program's Withdrawal Deadline can have their place cancelled.
- It is fine to confirm first, and then decide to withdraw, as long as you withdraw prior to your program's Withdrawal Deadline.

If during Pre-Reg you do not see the Off-Campus Block on your schedule, enroll in GS392 as a placeholder and contact Global Education. We will enroll you in the correct off-campus block course.

WHAT TO DO ONCE IN THE PROGRAM

- Retain your GPA over 2.00 to remain eligible
- Avoid disciplinary probations or suspensions
- Attend all pre-departure meetings
- Watch for emails from Global Education and your program's faculty
- Confirm your passport is valid 6 months past the program, and if not, apply or renew right away. It can take weeks to get a new passport.

WHAT IF YOU NEED TO WITHDRAW?

- In Summit, click "Request Cancellation" to withdraw.
- Cancel by the program's withdrawal deadline to avoid all charges.
BK 1-2: May 1 BK 3-4: Aug 1 BK 5-6: Oct. 1 BK 7-8 Dec. 1
- Withdrawal after the deadline requires a payment of 25% of the program fee.
- The withdrawal fee increases to 75% in the block prior to departure.
