

## Classes of 2014 and 2015, Five-Years Out

Colorado College queried graduates of the classes of 2014 and 2015, regarding their post-graduate activities, including any postgraduate education and career experience. Survey responses represent 31.1% of the Class of 2014 and 22.3% of the Class of 2015. This summary report includes abbreviated detail collected through the survey, as well as supplemental data collected.

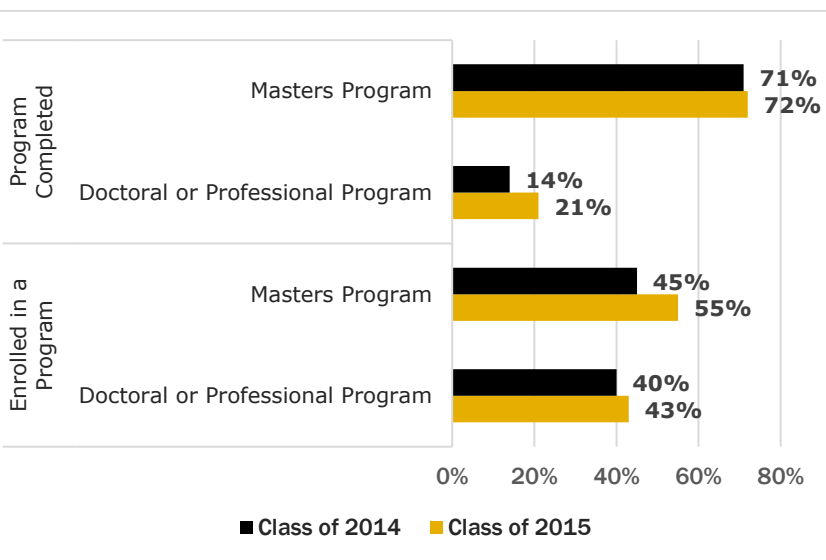
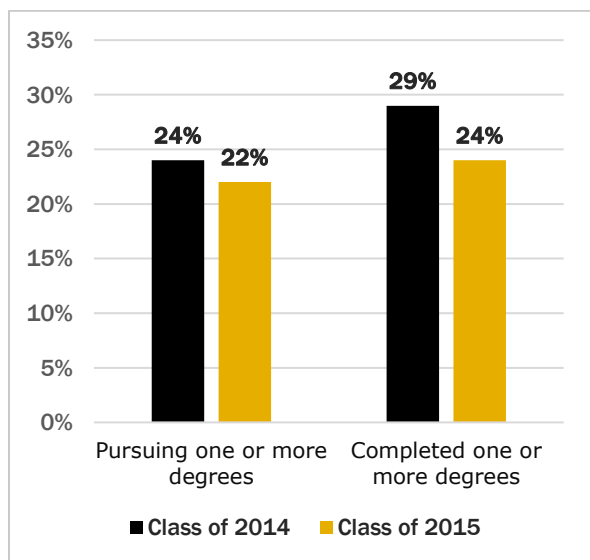
### Location

*91% of Class of 2014 and 95% of the Class of 2015 survey respondents reported living in the U.S.*

*31% of the Class of 2014 and 31% of the Class of 2015 respondents reported living in Colorado*

### Post-Graduate Educational Activity

In order to create a profile which was as representative of the graduating class as possible, the college combined post-graduate educational data collected from the surveys with data gathered from the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). Of alumni graduating in the classes of 2014 and 2015, for whom information on postgraduate educational pursuits was available through either the Colorado College Alumni Survey or the National Student Clearinghouse (as of August 2019 and August 2020):






*Note: Figures represent the proportion of students pursuing/having completed degrees out of all students with known post-graduate academic pursuits. For the class of 2014, this number is 245 alumni, or 47.4% of the entire class. For the class of 2015, this is 214 alumni, or 44.2% of the entire class.*

\*Degree field percentages for both years are calculated within their respective categories of pursued or completed.

Approximately **14%** of 2014 and **8%** of 2015 graduates (of those with known educational pursuits) attended a **University of Colorado** institution, making this the most frequently attended by alumni in both years.

### Employment, Fields, and Salaries\*

**Fifty-four percent** of 2014 graduates and **63%** of 2015 graduates were found to be employed, either through survey responses or LinkedIn profiles. Of those employed:

- **Technology/Information science** was the most common employment field for both classes. This represented **14%** of known employment for the Class of 2014 and **13%** for the Class of 2015
- **Eight percent** of the Class of 2014 and **9%** of the Class of 2015 reported currently starting or having started a company.\*

\* Percentages of those starting a company were calculated using only respondents to the pertaining questions, representing 22.6% of the entire graduating class of 2014 and 15.9% of the class of 2015.

Median reported salary range was \$55,000-59,999 for the Class of 2014 and \$60,000 – 69,999 for the Class of 2015*

\* Salary ranges in both years are based on survey respondents who reported full-time employment and provided salary data, representing 18% of the entire 2014 class and 11.6% of the entire 2015 class.

### Volunteer Service

**Eighty-eight percent** of the Class of 2014 survey respondents reported involvement in community-service or philanthropic endeavors, while **67%** of the Class of 2015 survey respondents reported this.
