## A Resolution Supporting Colorado Proposition CC

- 4 WHEREAS Colorado Proposition CC (the "Allow State to Retain Excess Revenue for
- 5 Transportation and Education Measure") is on the ballot in Colorado for the November 5, 2019
- 6 election as a legislatively referred state statute;
- 7 & WHEREAS if passed by a simple majority of voters, Proposition CC would allow the state,
- 8 without raising taxes, to retain excess revenue it is currently required to refund under the
- 9 Taxpayer's Bill of Rights (TABOR);
- 10 & WHEREAS the excess funds retained under Proposition CC would be used to provide funding
- 11 for public schools, higher education, roads, bridges and transit;
- 22 & WHEREAS additional funding for higher education will allow institutions of higher education
- across Colorado to improve student retention and graduation rates;
- 44 & WHEREAS additional funding for higher education will allow our public peer institutions to
- better control tuition increases and will allow for more investment to be made in their student
- educational programs, student success and performance, student well-being, and job readiness;
- 47 & WHEREAS additional funding for higher education will allow the state of Colorado to grow
- its talent pipeline, strengthen its economy, and remain competitive in an increasingly complex
- 19 global marketplace;
- 20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Colorado College Student Government Association supports and
- 21 endorses voting in favor of Proposition CC to allow the state of Colorado to retain excess
- revenue as a means of increasing general fund availability in future years to improve higher
- education and to benefit all of Colorado.
