




ENVIRONMENT AT THE BALLOT BOX



89% of Coloradans say that issues involving clean water, wildlife, and public lands are important in deciding whether to support an elected public official.




ENERGY ON PUBLIC LANDS



75% think that oil and gas development on national public lands should be stopped or strictly limited, as opposed to expanded.

RECREATION



PROTECTING LAND, WATER & WILDLIFE



83% support a national goal of protecting 30 percent of America's lands and waters by 2030.



86% support creating new national parks, national monuments, national wildlife refuges, and tribal protected areas.

FIRE & DROUGHT CONCERNS

88% are concerned about more frequent and severe wildfires.

77% think that wildfires in the West are more of a problem than they were 10 years ago.

89% are concerned about droughts and reduced snowpack.

ACTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

68% support gradually transitioning to one hundred percent clean, renewable energy over the next ten to fifteen years.

69% say that there is enough evidence of climate change that action should be taken.
