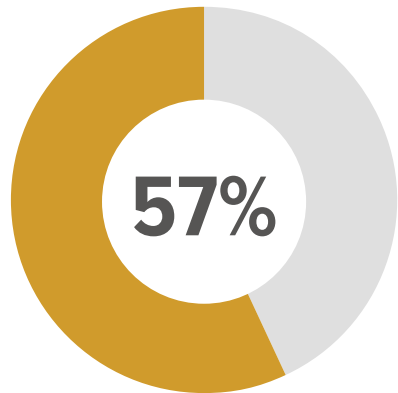
44% Ensuring we protect sources of clean water, our air quality and wildlife habitat while providing opportunities to visit and recreate on our national public lands

39% Ensuring we produce more domestic energy by maximizing the amount of national public lands available for responsible oil and gas drilling and mining

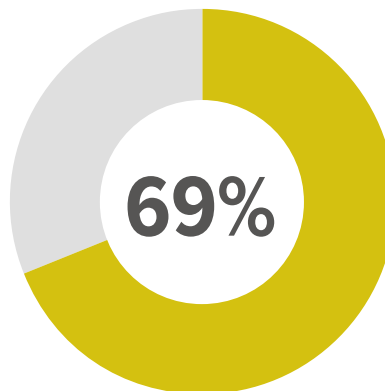
32% of Wyomingites disapprove of the way the Trump administration is handling issues related to land, water and wildlife. **59% approve.**

Oppose eliminating protections for national monuments

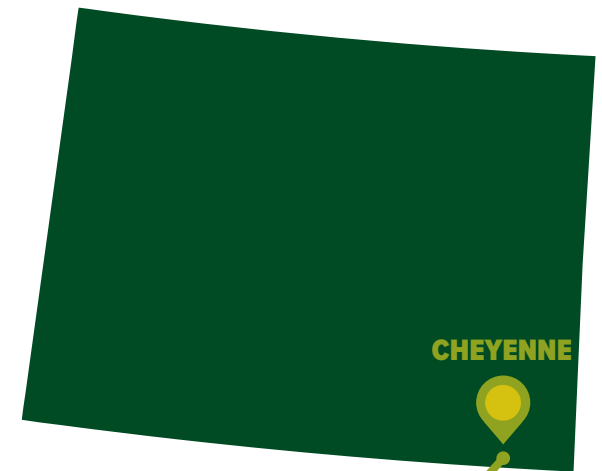
“Would you say that it is — a good idea or a bad idea — to reduce the size or protections at other national monuments?”

Wyoming's outdoor recreation economy

98% of Wyomingites think the outdoor recreation economy — meaning people who come to hunt, fish, camp, see wildlife, as well as those who manufacture and sell equipment for those activities — is **important to the economic future of the state.**

79% of Wyomingites think the presence of public lands and a lifestyle of outdoor recreation gives the West an **economic advantage over other parts of the country.**
